Sermon Title: *The Characteristics of a Defiant Man*

Text: Exodus 5:1-9

Point: Pharaoh's attitude and actions toward the request from Moses and Aaron give us a description of the defiant man.

1) The Defiant Man May Plead Ignorance (v.2).

2) The Defiant an Resists the Voice of the Lord (v. 2).

3) The Defiant Man is Not Open to Reason (v.3).

4) The Defiant Man Shifts Blame to Others (v. 4-5, 8-9).

5) The Defiant Man Treats Others with HARshness (v. 6-9).


