**Text:** Exodus 6:28-7:7

**Point:** God promises to demonstrate to His people and His enemies that He is the Lord.

1) **God Reiterates His call to Moses (6:28-29).**

2) **God Tells Moses How He Will Demonstrate That He is The Lord (7:1-7).**

A) **God will make Moses as a God in the eyes of Pharaoh (7:1).**

B) **God will make Aaron His spokesman (7:2).**

C) **God will harden Pharaoh's heart (7:3).**

D) **God will bring His people out of Egypt with dreadful judgments (7:4).**

E) **God will show Egypt that He is the Lord (7:5).**
