God Reveals His Holy Will

Reading of the Law: Exodus 20:16; WSC, Questions 76-78

Q. 76. Which is the ninth commandment?

A. The ninth commandment is, Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Q. 77. What is required in the ninth commandment?

A. The ninth commandment requireth the maintaining and promoting of truth between man and man, and our own and our neighbor's good name, especially in witness-bearing.

Q. 78. What is forbidden in the ninth commandment?

A. The ninth commandment forbiddeth whatsoever is prejudicial to truth, or injurious to our own or our neighbor's good name.

Corporate Confession of Sin (unison)

O Father, we are gathered before You, the Maker of Heaven and Earth, whose Chosen dwelling place is with the broken and the contrite, to confess that we have sinned in thought, word, and deed. We have not loved You with all our heart and all our soul. We have not loved You with all our mind and strength. We have not loved our neighbor as ourselves. We beseech You not to leave us in sorrow, because with You, O Lord, there is forgiveness, that we may fear You. In Your mercy, restore to us the joy of our salvation, so that we may love You with a holy love. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon: 1 Peter 1:18-19

Knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot.

Exhortation to New Obedience: 1 Corinthians 5:7-8

Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.
