God Calls Us To Confession

Call to Confess Our Sins: Psalm 32:9

Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you.

Corporate Confession of Sin (unison)

O Father, we are gathered before You, the Maker of Heaven and Earth, whose chosen dwelling place is with the broken and the contrite, to confess that we have sinned in thought, word, and deed. We have not loved You with all our heart and all our soul. We have not loved You with all our mind and strength. We have not loved our neighbor as ourselves. In Your mercy, deepen our sorrow for the wrong that we have done, and for the good we have left undone, so that we may hate our sin with a holy hatred. We beseech You not to leave us in sorrow, because with You, O Lord, there is forgiveness, that we may fear You. In Your mercy, restore to us the joy of our salvation, so that we may love You with a holy love. Amen.
