Sermon Title: *The Sabbath Observed*

Text: Exodus 16:21-36

Point: God provides for the physical and spiritual needs of His people. He instituted the weekly Sabbath as one day in seven set apart to Him, so that we would remember His provision, rest in His provision, and give thanks for His provision.

1) **God Institutes the Sabbath (v. 22-26).**

2) **God Gives Rest on the Sabbath (v. 27-30).**

3) **God Memorializes the Sabbath (v. 31-36).**

*The Law of God:
