Q. 73. Which is the eighth commandment?

**A. The eighth commandment is, Thou shalt not steal.**

Q. 74. What is required in the eighth commandment?

**A. The eighth commandment requireth the lawful procuring and furthering the wealth and outward estate of ourselves and others.**

Q. 75. What is forbidden in the eighth commandment?

**A. The eighth commandment forbiddeth whatsoever doth or may unjustly hinder our own or our neighbor's wealth or outward estate.**
