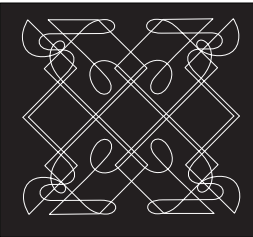

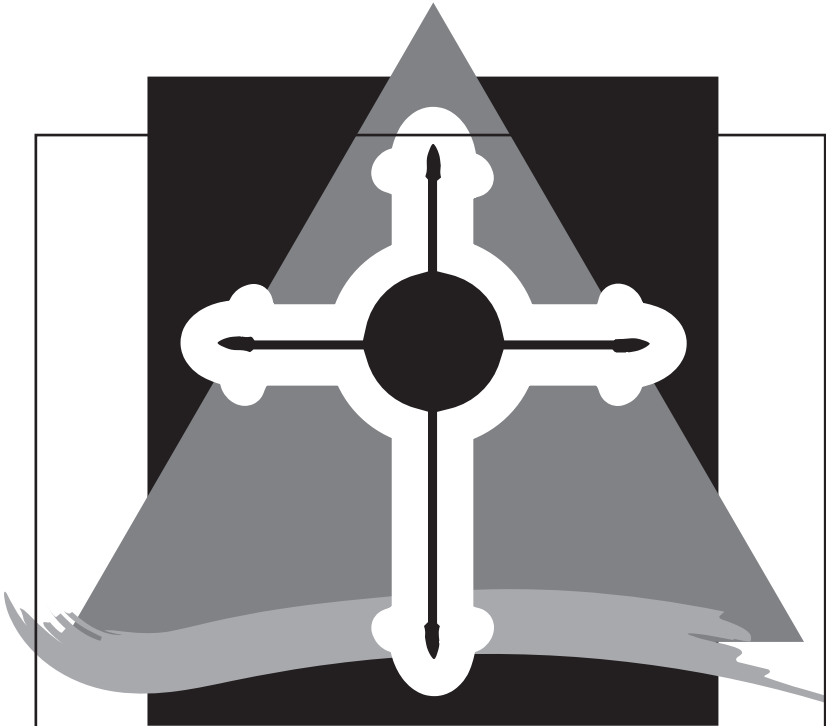

**Seek the LORD and his strength; seek his presence continually!**

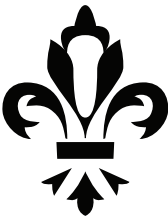
**\*Salutation:** Revelation 1:4b-5 (ESV)
